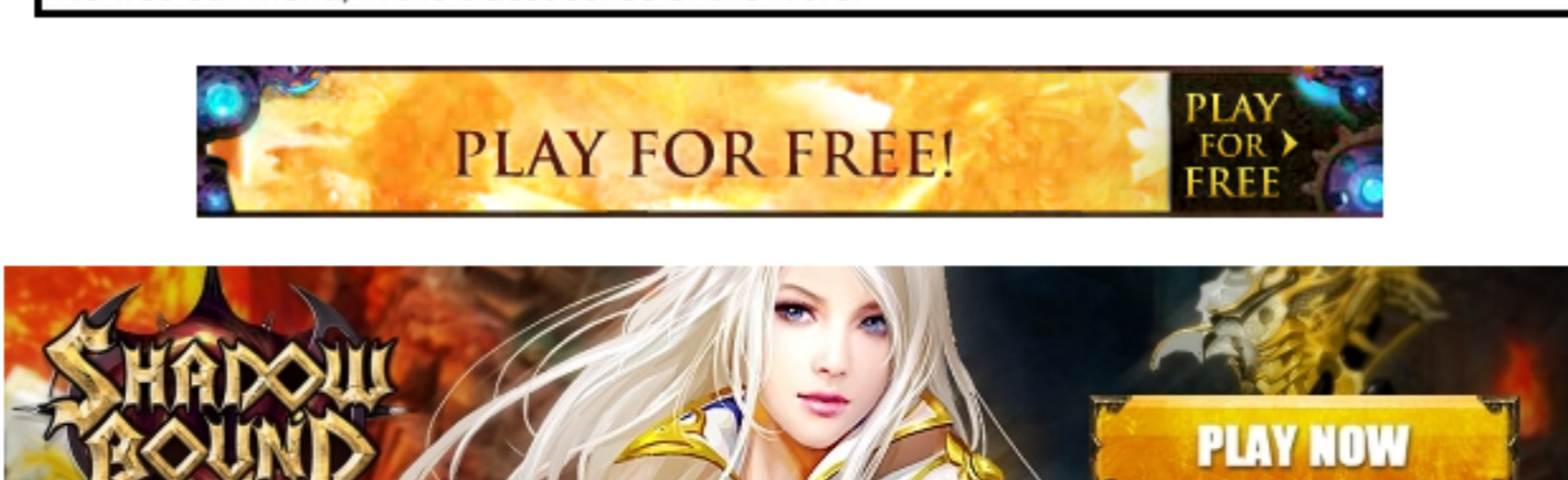

Rall was instrumental in getting his guild, Gaiscioch, to set up a branch in Guild Wars 2 after researching about the game. Sadly, his guild members found out about his death after he went offline for a couple of weeks last fall.

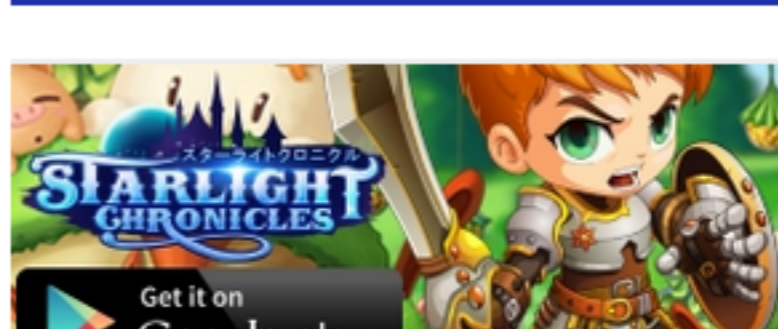

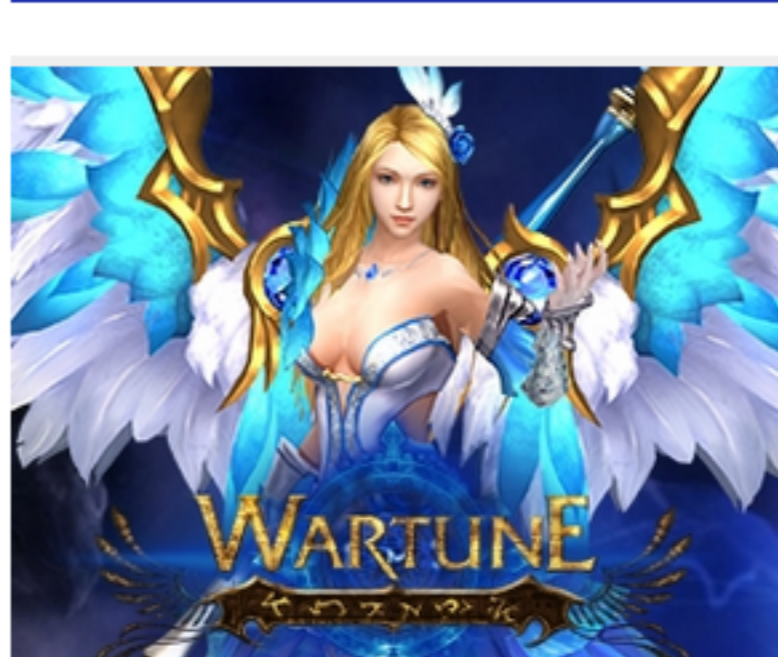

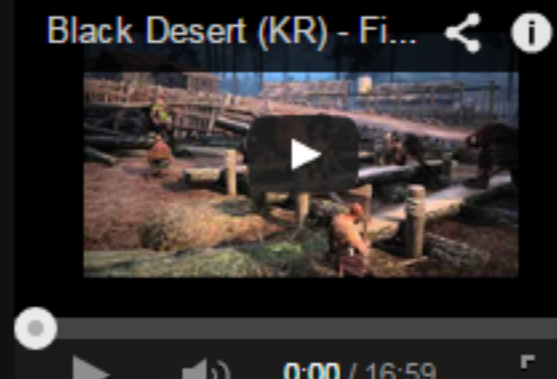
